A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AWARING RFP FY#2018-2019-009 FOR CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH WATER TREATMENT PLANT NANO FILTRATION MEMBRANE REPLACEMENT TO HARN R/O SYSTEMS, INC.; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO EFFECTUATE THE PROJECT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-4, Competitive Bidding Required, all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000 shall be based on competitive bids. Furthermore, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-6, Award of Contract, the City Manager, shall have the authority to recommend to the City Commission award of contracts; and

WHEREAS, the City has been operating for ten (10) years with the same membrane elements. Due to the Water Plant staff having a rigorous element cleaning schedule, the Membrane elements have worked beyond their normal life expectancy of five years; and

WHEREAS, the Water Plant Membrane Elements are currently beyond their normal life expectancy and are now showing minor signs of degradation; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2019, the City issued an Invitation to Bid for BID # FY 2018-2019-009 CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH WATER TREATMENT PLANT NANO FILTRATION MEMBRANE REPLACEMENT, which was sent via email to four hundred and seventy-eight (478) vendors from the City's Vendor list. The Bid was also advertised in the Hallandale Beach Chamber of Commerce website, City's website, DEMANDSTAR website, Sun-Sentinel and City and HBCRA Social Media pages; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2019, the bid opened with two (2) vendors responding to the solicitation. Staff evaluated the responses and determined that Harn R/O Systems, Inc. is the responsive and lowest bidder in the amount of \$621,800; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.

56 upon its adoption.


