**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,  
AUTHORIZING AWARD OF RFP # FY 2021-2022-014  
DISASTER DEBRIS MONITORING SERVICES CONTRACT  
TO EISMAN AND RUSSO, INC.; AND PROVIDING AN  
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hallandale Beach is vulnerable to natural disasters including hurricanes, tornadoes, windstorms, floods, and fires, that necessitate pre-need, pre-event contracts with qualified/experienced emergency and debris management firms responsible for monitoring and for removing, and lawfully disposing of disaster generated debris from public property and public maintained right-of ways during a disaster or emergency event; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-4, Competitive Bidding Required, all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000.00 shall be based on competitive bids. Furthermore, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23- 6, Award of Contract, the City Manager, shall have the authority to recommend to the City Commission award of contracts; and

**WHEREAS**, May 31, 2022, the City released RFP # FY 2021-2022-014 Disaster Debris Monitoring Services for the monitoring of such debris; and

**WHEREAS**, City Staff recommends that the City Commission award RFP # FY 2021-2022-014 Disaster Debris Monitoring Services contract to Eisman & Russo, Inc., determined to be the highest ranked vendor.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby award RFP # FY 2021-2022-014 Disaster Debris Monitoring Services to the highest ranked vendor, Eisman & Russo, Inc., and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.


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**SECTION 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
