MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT # 2: 10% BID BOND REQUIREMENT

As per Procurement Code Section 23-12 (2) Security Bonds, each proposer must provide with the submission of the Proposal a Security Bid Bond issued by a surety company licensed to do business in the state in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of Base Collection Services Estimated Annualized Cost from the Cost Proposal Form (Line 3) proposed by the firm. A Firm shall forfeit the Security Bid Bond if the Firm refuses or fails to execute the Agreement within fifteen (15) calendar days from the Notice to Proceed.

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As per Procurement Code Section 23-12 (2) Security Bonds, each proposer must provide with the submission of the Proposal a Security Bid Bond issued by a surety company licensed to do business in the state in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the aggregate of Total Annualized Cost for Residential Collection (Line 6), Total Annual Estimated Cost for Commercial Collection Services (Line 9), and Total Annual Estimated Cost for Multifamily Collection Services (Line 11).

Code of Ordinances, Chapter 23 Procurement, Section 23-14 Cone of Silence – imposes a Cone of Silence for City purchases of goods and services. The Cone of Silence means prohibition on any communication regarding a particular RFP, RFQ, ITB, RFI, or any other advertised solicitation between a potential proposer, offeror, respondent, bidder, lobbyist or consultant and the city's staff including, but not limited to, the city manager and his/her staff; the evaluation/selection committee; the mayor; and the city commission and their respective staff. The Cone of Silence shall be imposed when a formal competitive solicitation has been issued and shall remain in effect until an award is made, a contract is approved, or the Commission/Board of Directors takes any other action which ends the solicitation.
