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21 **WHEREAS**, the City of Hallandale Beach owns, operates, and maintains the water
22 treatment plant which services approximately 40,000 people within the City's corporate limits; and
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24 **WHEREAS**, the City of Hallandale Beach has elected to continue utilizing City water for
25 the longest extent possible by incorporating provisions to the existing water treatment plant that
26 can accommodate higher salinity raw water; and
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28 **WHEREAS**, as a precaution to safeguard against intrusion of saltwater into the City's
29 wellfield, the City of Hallandale Beach will install one reverse osmosis (RO) skid within the existing
30 membrane treatment facility, capable of treating potential increasing saline raw water, thus
31 providing additional flexibility and redundancy in our drinking water operations; and
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33 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-4, Competitive Bidding Required, all
34 purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated
35 cost shall exceed \$50,000.00, shall be based on competitive bids.
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37 **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission approve awarding
38 Bid # FY 2020-2021-016 Water Treatment Plant Reverse Osmosis Skid Addition to TLC
39 Diversified, Inc. as the lowest responsive bidder.
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41 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**
42 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

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SECTION 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission approve awarding Bid # FY 2020-2021-016 Water Treatment Plant Reverse Osmosis Skid Addition to TLC Diversified, Inc. as the lowest responsive bidder, in the amount not to exceed Three Million, Nine Hundred Thousand, Four Hundred and Forty-Four Dollars (\$3,984,444) plus a ten (10%) contingency of Three Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand, Four Hundred and Forty-five Dollars (\$398,445) for a not to exceed amount of Four Million, Three Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighty-Nine Dollars (\$4,382,889) and approving of transfer of additional funds of Six Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand, Two Hundred and Thirty Dollars (\$676,230) from the water utility fund to complete the construction of the project, and authorizing the City Manager to execute all relating documents to effectuate the purchase.


SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
